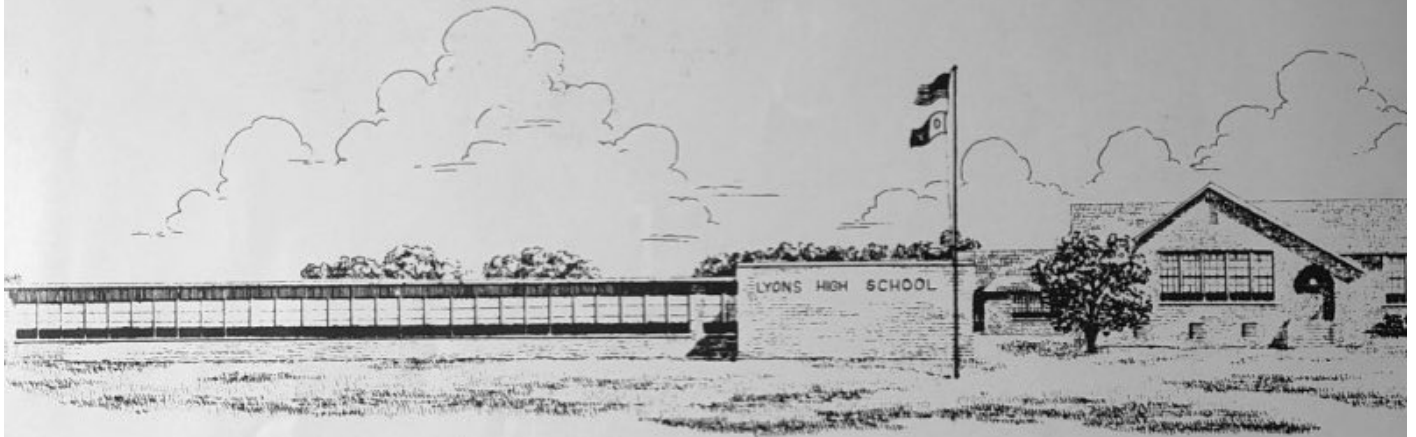

Evelle Gibbs was named Star Student of Lyons High School. The honor is based on academic grades and the score on the College Entrance Examination.

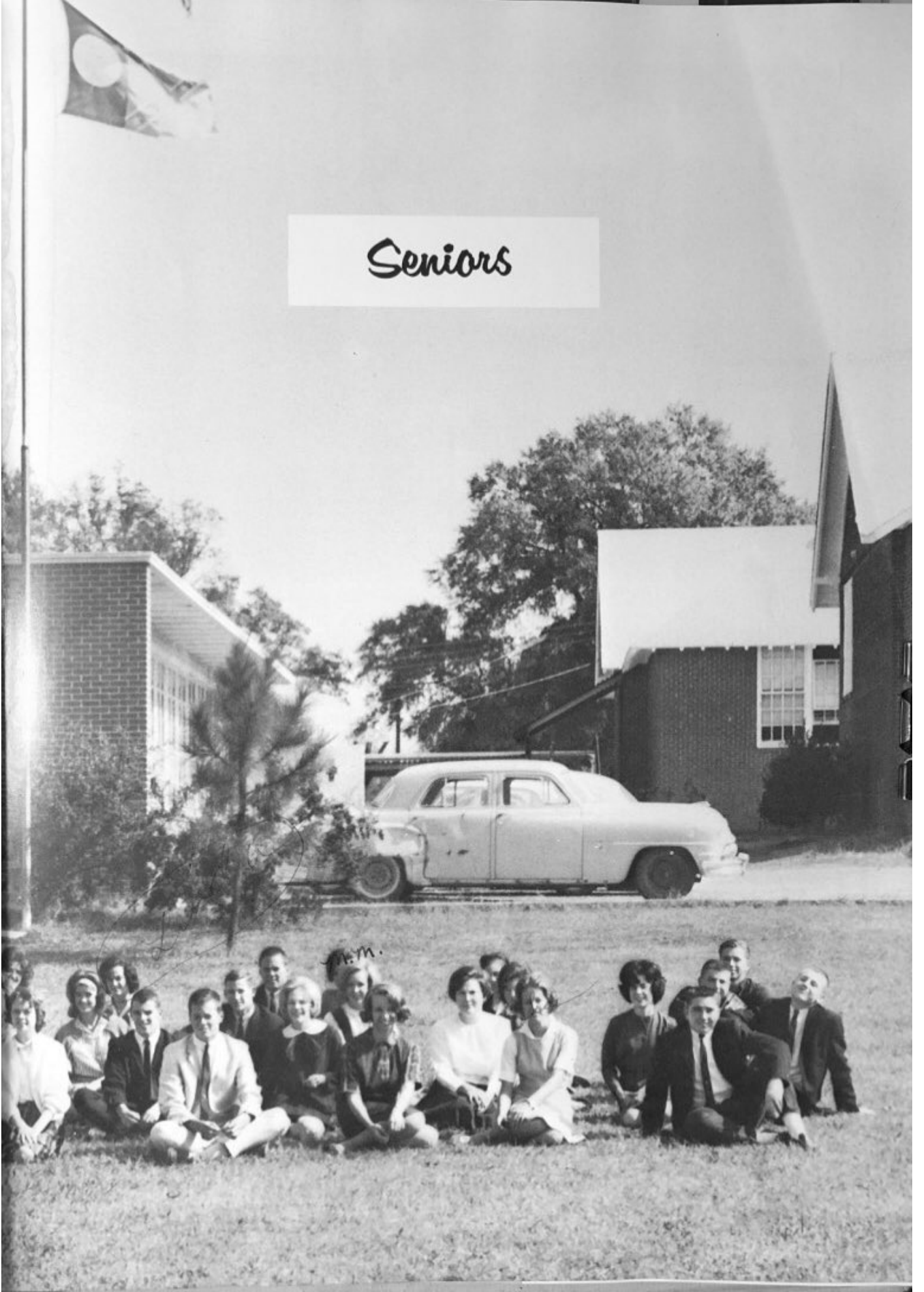
Evelle chose Mr. J. H. Collins as the teacher who contributed the most to her high school education.
